I also authorize the hospital director and staff to provide veterinary services as requested or in emergency circumstances to follow through with such procedures as are necessary for the well being of my pet on a continuing basis until further advised. I understand that I assume financial responsibility for all services rendered and that payment is due in full at the time of discharge.

## PREANESTHETIC BLOODWORK & IV CATHETER

These procedures increase the safety of any anesthetic procedure. The preanesthetic bloodwork lets us evaluate your pet's basic physiologic condition. Knowing how certain organs such as liver and kidney's are functioning is important prior to anesthesia. These organs are responsible for eliminating anesthetic from the body. The CBC is useful in identifying white and red blood cell abnormalities that reveal anemia, infections, etc. An IV catheter placed prior to surgery will allow for an easy route to give medication if an anesthetic complication should occur.
